Try to imagine the situations described below, even if some seem very unlikely.
Use the code that best suits your current state

- If you had plenty of money, how much would you pay over the normal price for a dose of heroin that would be the last available for the next 24 hours?
 - (0) I would not buy the heroin
 - (1) Not one penny;
 - (2) A reasonable amount, but not over 50% of the normal price;
 - (3) Probably any amount;
 - (4) Definitely any amount.
- You only have half the usual dose for the next 10 hours, after which you will only have another half. What will you do?
 - (0) I do not care about heroin because I don't need it;
 - (1) I will wait for 10 hours so that I can take the full dose and get a good 'sensation';
 - (2) I will try to wait, but I will take the first half before the 10 hours is over;
 - (3) I will take it immediately, because I cannot resist it;
 - (4) I will take it immediately, and I will then take something to cheer me up like alcohol, tranquillizers, amphetamines or cocaine.
- The only syringe available does not look good. It could be that someone with an infection has used the syringe. What will you do?
 - (0) I will not inject. In any case, I think that every addict must use his/her own syringe and just once;
 - (1) If the syringe does not look good, I will not inject;

7. They have finally invented the 'anti-withdrawal' pill, which does not take away the 'desire for heroin' but does not make you feel down, either. Next week there will be no heroin. What will you do?

(0) I will not use any and the problem has nothing to do with me, anyway;

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8. For some reason, a friend of yours has decided to give you a bit of heroin. You are trying to rehab.
